MASTER PLANNING REPORT

At the Conference of Delegates (CoD) meeting on Wednesday, August 13, the CoD approved the Master Planning Committee's recommendation to select I+S Group as the Architectural Design Firm to assist in completing the Facility Study and Master Plan. Meetings with I+S Group kicked off in late August and initially focused on completing the Facility Study and then use the facility information to help complete the Master Plan.

At the last CoD meeting on Wednesday, November 12, representatives from I+S Group presented their initial facility assessment report which highlighted the current status in the following areas:

- A. Site Conditions
- B. Exterior and Interior Building Conditions
- C. Structural Conditions
- D. Accessibility Conditions
- E. Safety Conditions
- F. Plumbing, Mechanical and Electrical Conditions

I+S Group will continue their facility study and develop several site plan options which will be used to complete the Master Plan by early January 2015. The Master Planning Steering Committee will forward the results and recommendations to the Board and Conference of Delegates.
