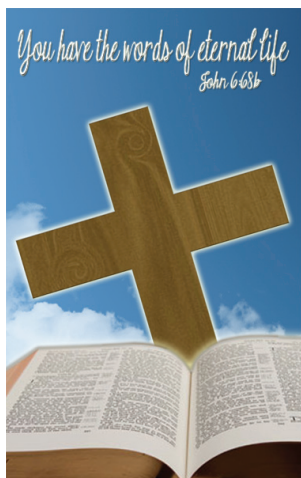

Building Safety

Welcome to Luther High School. Beginning this school year visitors to Luther High School during the school day will notice signs directing them to the office. For those visitors purchasing SCRIP in the office or taking care of other matters in the office, the sign will be the only observable change. Visitors who need to see someone in other parts of the building will need to sign the guest registry and wear a visitor pass.

Students arriving in the morning before the school day will still be able to enter through the ACE lobby. After the school day opening announcements and prayer all students and visitors are to enter through the Wilson Street entrance and register in the office.

Luther High School received assistance in developing an emergency response plan from the Onalaska Police and Fire departments, Tri-State Ambulance, and CESA. We are grateful for their assistance and expertise. During the school year we will be conducting emergency response drills. The September drill will be explained and announced to the students in advance. Other drills during the school year will be unannounced.
