

International Students

What an opportunity Luther High School will have in the 2014-15 school year! In recent years two international students have enrolled as students at LHS. Next year there may be six or more. In a special way "going into all the world to share the Gospel" is being reversed as students from China and Vietnam desire to have a Christ-centered education at Luther High School.

We are asking WELS families to consider hosting an international student for the 2014-15 school year. International students are to be considered part of the family and

subject to host family rules/expectations. To assist with the costs associated with hosting an international student, the host family will receive \$5000 for room & board. The host family will also receive \$2500 in tuition credit to be used for a current student. Should that not be a need for the host family, those funds will be directed to tuition assistance. Plan Ahead!

During the week of May 12, current LHS students will receive their 2014-15 athletic forms for completion. Incoming freshmen will receive their forms in the mail. These WIAA required forms must be submitted prior to any practice and include:

- Permission to Participate/Acknowledgement Form (Blue Card)
- Physical Card (Green Card)
- Emergency Contact (Medical Consent)
- Wisconsin State Concussion Forms

Generally, incoming Freshmen and next year's Juniors need physicals. Physicals completed on or after April 1 are good for the next two school years. If your son/daughter is in need of a physical, it would be wise to schedule your appointment now. The 2014-15 Athletic Handbooks will be available electronically on the LHS athletic webpage (www.luther.k12.wi.us). If you would like a printed copy, please call 783-5435 x361 (Dulcey Zillmer) to request your copy.

Our goal is to have all Blue Cards and Emergency Contact cards submitted prior to the last day of school. All necessary paperwork will be available in electronic form on the athletic webpage.
