



How Luther High School's Tuition Is Affordable for You **9 Sources of Tuition Assistance**

1. **SCRIP Program** - Gift cards and certificates to a wide variety of businesses are available for purchase through the school office. Using Scrip for purchases you normally would make can earn income to be credited to a current or future Luther High student. Details about the Scrip program are available in the school office.
2. **Tuition Assistance Application from Luther High School** - For WELS members (available in the office and on-line) FACTS Grant and Aid Assessments filing deadline is February 15th.
3. **Tuition Assistance from home congregation** (Ask your pastor if your congregation has such a program and who to contact)
4. **Good Steward Volunteer Program** (Contact Pastor Sachs for details) *166 students received grants through this program for the 2016-17 school year.*
5. **Family Support** (Perhaps a grandparent or sponsor would be able to provide financial assistance with tuition)
6. **Student Tuition Endowment Fund (STEF)** –Interest from this permanent fund can provide each Luther High student a tuition grant. *For the 2017-18 school year each student is eligible to receive \$80*
7. **Grant from Luther High School)** *For the 2017-18 school year each student is eligible to receive \$325*
8. **Grant from Friends of Luther** *For the 2017-18 school year each student is eligible to receive \$100*
9. **Grant from Good Steward Store** *For the 2017-18 school year each student is eligible to receive \$200*
