Freshmen Parents/Guardians,

Your son or daughter's course requests for next school year are available to select. An Advisor has been assigned to contact you and will help answer any questions you may have regarding this information.

Description of Freshmen Courses: (note – “A” courses are 1st semester and “B” courses are 2nd semester)

- **COMPUTER SKILLS** – required of all freshmen (includes keyboarding, word processing, spreadsheet and presentation software skills)
- **COMPUTER APPLICATIONS** – elective teaching programming, web design and 3D design
- **COMPUTER GRAPHICS** – elective teaching Adobe Photoshop, InDesign & Illustrator
- **ROBOTICS** – elective teaching basic engineering & programming through the use of Lego robotic kits
- **DIGITAL VIDEO I** – elective teaching creating, editing and producing video
- **PUBLICATIONS I** – elective course focused on publishing the school yearbook

- **INTRO TO THE TRADES** – elective teaching basic tool use, electrical, plumbing, construction, etc. (upper classmen have priority)
- **WOODWORKING** - elective (upper classmen have priority)
- **BUILDING CONSTRUCTION** – elective (upper classmen have priority)

- **INDIVIDUALIZED INSTRUCTIONAL ASSISTANCE** – scheduled through the coordinator, Mrs. Gail Bolstad. To request more information call (608) 783-5435 x1905 or bolsgail@luther.k12.wi.us

- **ENGLISH I** – required of all freshmen

- **ALGEBRA I** – elective
- **ALGEBRA 1-P1** – elective, first half of Algebra I made into a full year course (students would take ALGEBRA 1-P2 in their Sophomore year)
- **PRE-ALGEBRA 9** – generally determined by a combination of criteria (8th grade Math grades and/or consultation with 8th grade teacher and/or parent)
- **(GEOMETRY)** – this course is not listed because it is only available to those passing the Algebra I Challenge Exam. The exam is given at the grade schools usually in May. Please select Algebra I at this time.

Music Graduation Requirements

- *1 semester of either music classroom course (Music Appreciation 9-12, Music Theory 11-12, Digital Music 11-12)*
OR
- *4 semesters of any music performance course(s) in any combination of (Band 9-12, Cantate Choir 9, Concert Choir 10-12)*
- **MUSIC APPRECIATION** – classroom elective general music course to introduce students to music
- **(MUSIC THEORY)** – classroom elective (not listed because it is only offered to Jr/Sr students) theory music course
- **(DIGITAL MUSIC)** classroom elective (not listed because it is only offered to Jr/Sr students)
- **BAND** – performance elective, Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior & Senior course
- **CANTATE CHOIR** – performance elective, joint boys & girls Freshmen choir but listed separately by gender for study hall purposes

- **ART 3D/PHOTO** – elective (upper classmen have priority)
- **ART DRAW/PAINT** – elective (upper classmen have priority)
- **FITNESS & WELLNESS** – required of all freshmen
- **GOSPELS** – required of all freshmen
- **PHYSICAL SCIENCE** – required of all freshmen
- **WESTERN CIVILIZATION** – required of all freshmen
- **EAST/WEST GEOGRAPHY** – typically taken as a Sophomore, offered for special circumstances


