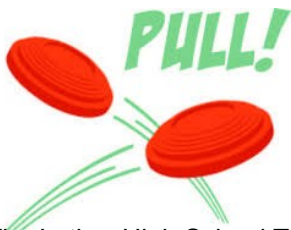

Fall Season Information

The Luther High School Trap Club will hold a meeting to discuss this upcoming fall season at the Holmen Gun Slick on Sunday, August 23 at 1:00 pm. Returning Trap Club members along with anyone that is interested in learning more about Luther's newest club should plan to attend. Veteran shooters will have their equipment with them so you can see what is used for trap shooting. We will also discuss the fall season dates for the 6-week league, which is held during September and October. What: Trap Club meeting to see what the club is about, shoot Clay targets, and discuss the 2020 Fall season

Where: Holmen Gun Slick (96767 Briggs Rd, Holmen, WI)

What to bring: Eye protection, ear protection, and any other shooting gear you may have (shooting vest or belt), Gun and shotgun shell lead only. If you don't have any of this but would still like to shoot please bring your shells and we will fit you with the rest of the gear to try it out.

Fall Sport Update

On Friday, August 14, the WIAA Board of Control approved plans for an alternate fall season for schools that desire or need to move the fall sport season from its traditional time frame. The plan creates four different seasons for the 2020-2021 school year: 1) Traditional Fall Season, 2) Modified Winter Season, 3) Alternate Fall Season (March-Early May), and 4) Modified Spring Season. Schools will have a September 1 deadline to determine which fall season in which to participate.

The WIAA identified low-risk sports of tennis and cross country began practices on Monday, August 17. The WIAA high-risk sports of volleyball and football are scheduled to begin on September 7. While some schools in our area have already announced that their fall sports will move to the alternate fall season, many others - including schools in the Coulee and our new football conference, the Scenic Bluffs, will be making that decision in the coming days ahead. Even though we have started tennis and cross country, it would still remain possible to move to the alternate fall season should that decision be made by the September 1 deadline.

Both options for the fall season (traditional or alternate) bring on unique challenges. Your school leadership asks for your prayers as it wrestles with this decision. We hope to be able to share the final direction with you in next week's update.
